

Town of New Hope Regular Board Meeting
Wednesday, August 19, 2015 - 7:00 p.m.

1. Call to Order.

Dan Zaborowski called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He opened the meeting leading us in the pledge of allegiance.

2. Review/Approval of Minutes.

The minutes of the last monthly meeting were read by Kari Yenter. Timm Raddatz moved to approve the minutes, seconded by Todd Knepfel. Motion carried.

3. Discussion and possible action on Sunset Lake Ordinance.

The Sunset Lake Ordinance was created in 1964. The Board agrees slow-no-wake should be in effect for this lake. The ordinance was discussed and possible changes were made to the ordinance. Timm Raddatz moved to propose the amendments to the ordinance and bring the ordinance back to the Board for possible approval, seconded by Todd Knepfel. Motion carried.

4. Bridge report.

Dan Zaborowski did not have any additional information on the bridge project on River Road.

5. Road Improvement report.

Most of the road projects are complete. Dan Zaborowski reviewed the amounts spent on road repairs and projects and the amounts budgeted for these items. Todd Knepfel reported nothing has been started on the bus turn around on North Lake Road and the south side of Waller Road where the culvert was extended is starting to wash away after the recent rains.

6. Resolution – Initiate process for discontinuing Oak Lane.

The resolution for initiating the process for discontinuing Oak Lane was read by Dan Zaborowski. The property owner affected is in support of the closure. Todd Knepfel moved to initiate the process to close Oak Lane and a Lis Pendens will be filed by the Clerk with the Portage County Register of Deeds, seconded by Timm Raddatz. Motion carried.

7. Recycling events.

The tire and appliance recycling events were discussed. The recycling events will most likely take place in October or November.

8. Payment of bills.

The website for the Town of New Hope and estimated costs were discussed. Todd Knepfel moved to pay the bills, seconded by Timm Raddatz. Motion carried.

9. Next meeting date.
